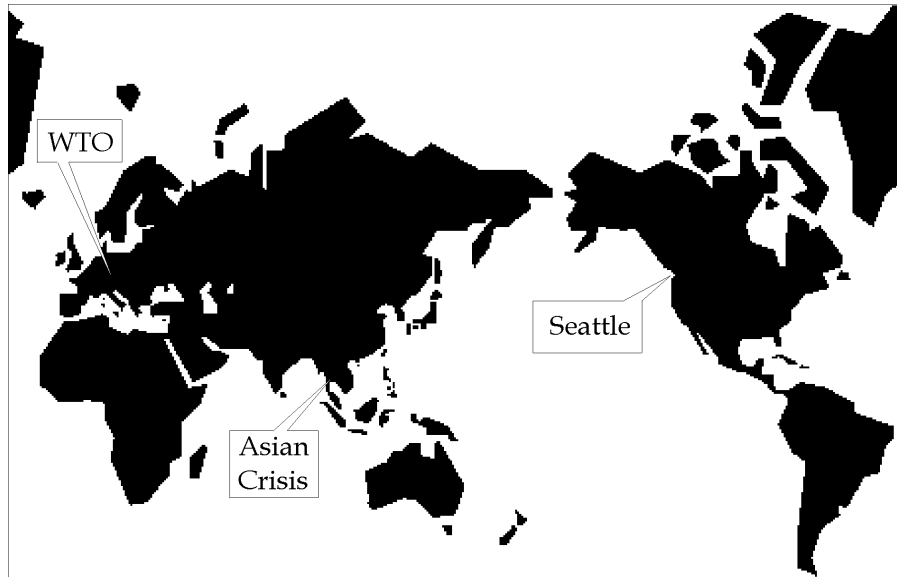


Seattle Workshop, '99

WTO and World Trade

Seattle, U. S. A., December 4, 1999



The next World Trade Organization (WTO) ministerial meeting will be held in Seattle, U. S. A., November 30 – December 3, 1999. This will be the largest trade event ever in the United States.

An international workshop is being organized for economists to share their views on the WTO, GATT, the world trade system, multilateral trade negotiations, and other current trade issues. This workshop, which will be sponsored by the Department of Economics and the Jackson School of International Studies, University of Washington, will be held on the campus of the university, December 4, 1999.
